DECEIVED (c, 3, Broken Vow--Naughty Natisha, by Known Fact) finished bridesmaid in each of his first three career starts, including a neck defeat over Belmont's one-turn mile Oct. 25. The bay scampered away from his rivals to graduate by 7 1/2 lengths trying two turns for the first time over a muddy local strip Dec. 7, but was most recently beaten nearly 20 lengths into third behind today's Gill Withers S. favorite Samraat (Noble Causeway) in the Dec. 18 Damon Runyon S. The 8-5 chalk settled in second for the opening five furlongs, was sent to the front nearing the stretch and kicked away to score by 8 1/4 lengths. Mental Iceberg (Freud) came with a late run for second. Deceived is a half to Naughty New Yorker (Quiet American), GSW & GISP, \$1,089,884; and 3/4 to Pupil (Unbridled), SW & MGSP, \$204,280. MARRIEDTOTHMUSIC (c, 4, Disco Rico--Significant Other, by Not for Love) twice won for \$35,000 claiming tags, but has taken his game to a new level, and a return to stakes company beckons following this allowance romp. Runner-up in the restricted Claramount S. at Saratoga Aug. 7, he filled the same spot in an Aug. 24 optional tagger at the Spa before getting the rest of the year off. The chestnut resurfaced in a first-level state-bred allowance over course and trip Jan. 18, bolting up by a half-dozen lengths, and was the 1-4 chalk to repeat the dose here. Marriedtothemusic caught a flyer leaving the gates and soon had open lengths on his rivals. He covered the opening half-mile in a swift :45.45 and streaked home to score by 9 3/4 lengths. EMPOWER (c, 3, Distorted Humor--Magnificence {GSW, \$163,378}, by Stormy Atlantic) took action all the way into 5-2 for his six-furlong debut at Gulfstream Park Dec. 19, but little went right that day, as he was wide and trailed in ninth. He found himself on a van back to New York a few days later and was getting Lasix for this two-turn debut after racing without the medication first time out. A stalking second as Read the Mirage (Forestry) set just a moderate pace, Empower was roused to the lead in upper stretch, dueled briefly with the front-runner into the final furlong, then held off a late run from Killer Crossover (Indian Charlie) to score by 1 1/2 lengths as the narrow 3.05-1 favorite. Howl (Arch), the joint-second choice at 3.30-1, stumbled out of the gate and never landed a blow in sixth, while Supermonic (Latent Heat) brushed the gate at the break, lost his footing a few strides later and finished seventh. The winner's dam was purchased for an even \$1 million at Fasig-Tipton November in 2008. Magnificence produced a full-sister to Empower in 2012 and is the dam of a yearling colt by Lonhro (Aus).
